Dr. Ali is a native Brahui speaker from traditional background. He got his Ph.D. from the University of Balochistan in 2014 (dissertation title: *Research and*

Critical Analysis of Brahui Modern Poetry). He teaches Brahui since 2005, and wrote four books and many articles on the Brahui language and poetry.


