## **WORKSHOP ON FIELD LINGUISTICS**

International School of Dravidian Linguistics conducted a workshop on Field Linguistics with the co-operation of the Department of Linguistics, University of Kerala. The venue of the Workshop was the International School of Dravidian Linguistics and its period was 10<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> October 2022. On the first day the inaugural function was held at ISDL campus at 10 am in which the welcome address was by Dr. S.A. Shanavas, Professor, Department of Linguistics, University of Kerala and the Chairman the Session was Prof. G.K. Panikkar, Director, International School of Dravidian linguistics. Inaugural address was delivered by Prof. Shailendra Mohan, Director, Central Institute of Indian languages, Mysore. He explained the various aspects of Field Linguistics in an exhaustive way. Professor Shailendra Mohan discussed the role of technology in field work, ethics in field work, why do we do field work etc. Various scholars participated in this workshop both offline and online. Following the event Dr. N. Muraleedharan Nair, Treasurer, ISDL proposed the vote of thanks to all the guests and to all the participants who attend the workshop both as online and offline.

## 1<sup>st</sup> day (10-10-2022)

The academic sessions started at 11.30 am. The first session commenced with an online lecture by **Prof. L. Ramamoorthy**, Central University of Kerala on the topic **Current Trends in Field Linguistics**. He discussed the tools in field linguistics, what are the uses of documentation and who are the users of documentation etc. Following the lecture there was a lunch break. After that **Prof. Kavita Rastogi** from Luknow University delivered an online lecture on the topic **Challenges of Documenting an Endangered Language**. She explicated about the selection of informants, various elicitation methods in Field Linguistics. After that **Prof. Sreenathan**, Malayalam University, Tirur elucidated Field Linguistics.

## $2^{nd} \; day (11\text{-}10\text{-}2022)$

The session started at 10 am. In this session there were two online lectures and two offline lectures.

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**Prof. Sreenathan**, Malayalam University, Tirur delivered the first lecture. He discussed the field tools, characteristics of cultural shock, symptoms of cultural shock etc. **Prof. Panchanan Mohanthy**, Former Director, CALTS, University of Hyderabad delivered an online lecture on the importance of Historical Linguistics in Filed linguistics. Following the lunch break Prof. Umamaheswara Rao, Former Director, CALTS, University of Hyderabad delivered a lecture on Field Linguistics: Case Studies in **Dravidian**. Last lecture of the session was by Dr. Darwin L. Assistant Professor, Department of Linguistics, University of Kerala. He discussed on the topic Linguistic field method & strategies.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> day (12-10-2022)

On the third day the first session was started at 10 am by the online lecture by **Prof. K. Rangan**, formerly of Tamil University Thanjavur. His lecture was on subjectivity and objectivity the the data. Second lecture Dr.S.A.Shanavas, Professor, Department of linguistics, University of Kerala. He delivered the lecture on Corpus based **Field Linguistics**. After the lunch break Dr. S. Kunjamma, Professor, Department of linguistics, University of Kerala delivered a lecture on the topic Field Linguistics: Sociolinguistic Field work. In this session last lecture was by **Dr. S. Prema**, Assistant professor, Department of linguistics, University of Kerala on the topic Glossing Techniques.

## 4<sup>th</sup> day (13-10-2022)

First lecture in this session was by **Prof. C. Maheswaran**, Former Director,

Tribal Research Centre, Govt. of Tamilnadu on the topic **Field work Tradition in Linguistics.** He explained the etic and emic approaches in linguistic items, and the procedures adopted while organizing the field work etc. Following the lunch break **Prof. G.K. Panikkar**, Director, ISDL explained the various aspects of Field Linguistics. Last online lecture was by **Prof. Shailendra Kumar Singh,** North Eastern Hill University, Shillong.

## $5^{th}$ day(14-10-2022)

On the fifth day the first session started at 10 am and the first lecture was by **Prof. G.K. Panikkar**, Director, ISDL. He discussed Field Linguistics from a historical perspective. After the tea break Prof. V. Gnanasundaram, Former Deputy Director, CIIL, Mysuru discussed Language Endangerment and Field Linguistics. He explained the language endangerment and the aspects of it. Following the lunch break Prof. Renuga Devi, (Retd) Prof. & Department of Linguistics, Madurai Kamaraj University delivered a lecture on Field procedures **Questionnaires.** She explained two important methods to gather the data and various steps in each method.

## 6<sup>th</sup> day (15-10-2022)

Two memorial lectures were presented in the last day of the workshop. The session started at 10 am. **Prof. M.Rama**. Former Director, ISDL was the Chairman of the Session. Prof. P. Somasekharan Nair Memorial **lecture** was delivered by **Prof.** Gnanasundaram, Former Deputy Director, CIIL, Mysuru. He discussed the bilingual method for collecting

data, types of questionnaires Prof. A.P Andrewskutty Memorial lecture was delivered by Prof. Renuga Devi, (Retd) Prof. & Head, Department Linguistics, Madurai of University. She has stated that proper procedure is absolutely essential to adequate analysis of the description of the language.

Following the lunch break valedictory function started at 2 pm. Welcome address was by Dr. S. Abdul Secretary, Samad. DLA Chairman of the session was **Dr. S. Kunjamma**, Professor, Department of linguistics, University of Kerala. Valedictory address was delivered through online by Dr. M.J Warsi, Chairman, Department of Linguistics, Aligarh Muslim University. Dr. S.A. Shanavas, Professor, Department of University linguistics, of presented the report of the workshop. Following the event Muhammad Ashraf K, Research Scholar, Department of linguistics, University of Kerala proposed the vote of thanks to all the participants, staff and research scholars. One week long most fruitful workshop came to a close at 5 pm.

# Ninth All India Conference of Dravidian Linguists

The 9<sup>th</sup> All India Conference of Dravidian Linguists originally scheduled to be held in the month of May 1991 was twice postponed due to the general election in some states and due to the assassination of the honourable Prime Minister of India Mr. Rajiv Gandhi. The inauguration of this Conference began at 10.30 am on the 11<sup>th</sup> of July 1991 and Justice V.S. Malimath (Rtd.) Chief Justice of Kerala inaugurated it. In his inaugural address, he reviewed the constitutional provisions for the protection of languages and welcomed the move to set up a National University for Dravidian Studies. S.M. Katre who was to be honoured at the conference could not come but sent a felicitation address which was read by Dr. G.K. Panikkar. Prof. B. Ramachandra Rao, former Vice-Chairman of the UGC Chairman of the General Council of ISDL presided over the function. He said that the persuasive ability of S.M. Katre responsible for the development of Linguistics in India. Dr. K. Retnamma while welcoming the guests, traced the history of DLA and ISDL. Secretary M. Rama proposed vote of thanks.
