The Dravidian Linguistics Association at its 43<sup>rd</sup> annual conference held in June 2015 at C.A.S. in Linguistics, Annamalai University decided to hold the 44<sup>th</sup> All India Conference of Dravidian Linguists at CALTS, University of Hyderabad. It was also decided to launch a comprising year-long program of an International Conference and a number of seminars and workshops throughout the year commemorating the bicentennial of Francis Whyte Ellis's (1816) publication establishing the concept of a family of languages spoken in the Subcontinent, later called as the Dravidian Family of Languages or South Indian Family of Languages by Rev. Robert Caldwell (1857). In accordance with the aspirations of the Dravidian linguists, it was decided to hold an International Conference on Dravidian Linguistics along with the 44<sup>th</sup> All India Conference of Dravidian Linguists at CALTS, **UNIVERSITY** OF **HYDERABAD** in collaboration with CENTRAL INSTITUTE OF INDIAN LANGUAGES, Mysore, DRAVIDIAN LINGUISTICS ASSOCIATION **INTERNATIONAL** SCHOOL and OF DRAVIDIAN LINGUISTICS from 16<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> June 2016.

#### First Announcement and Call for Papers

We are pleased to announce that the Centre for Applied Linguistics And Translation Studies, UNIVERSITY OF HYDERABAD, INDIA will host the International Conference of Dravidian Linguistics (ICDL-2016) and the 44<sup>th</sup> All India Conference of Dravidian Linguists (AICDL). Abstracts are invited for oral presentations on substantial, original and unpublished research pertaining to any aspect of theoretical and applied linguistics. The thrust area of the conference is Dravidian Linguistics. However, papers on other branches of Linguistics and related subjects will also be allowed. The following are a few broad areas for paper-presentation: Language Acquisition, Language Teaching and Learning, Brain and Language, Discourse Analysis, Phonetics and Phonology, Semantics, Comparative Linguistics, Historical Linguistics, Clinical Linguistics, Speech Synthesis, Mathematical Linguistics, Semiotics, Stylistics, IT and Linguistics, Morphology and Syntax, Pragmatics, Sign Language Studies, Translation Theories, Computational Linguistics, Neurolinguistics, Psycholinguistics, Sociolinguistics, Typology, Folkloristics, Tribal Studies, Cultural Studies and Palaeography.

# **VENUE:** The venue of the conference is *Centre for Applied Linguistics and Translation Studies, University of Hyderabad.*

**PAPERS:** The deadlines for submission of abstracts and full-length papers are **30<sup>th</sup> March 2016** and **10<sup>th</sup> May 2016** respectively. The abstract and full-length paper may please be sent, preferably through e-mail (*aicdl2016@ gmail.com*), to **Prof. G. Umamaheswara Rao**, Local Convener, ICDL-2016 & 44<sup>th</sup> All India Conference of Dravidian Linguists, CALTS, University of Hyderabad. Scholars are also requested to bring hard and soft copies of their abstracts and papers along with them. The language of the paper shall be English except for regional-language session if any. A registered participant can present only one paper. Please provide a computer printout of the abstract and full-length paper along with a soft copy.

**REGISTRATION:** The registration fee for the conference is Rs. 1,500/-. Life-members of DLA and students need to pay only Rs. 750/-. Bonafide students and research scholars have to produce a certificate from the respective Heads of Departments, stating their student status to avail of the concessional registration. 1. **Mrs. Katre Memorial Prize** for M.A. topper in Linguistics (2014-15), of Rs. 1,000/-. (The Universities and Heads of Departments are requested to forward mark lists.)

2. Award for the Best Paper in the Conference by a young full-time student or research scholar, of Rs. 1,000/-. (Only bona fide students and full-time research scholars, who have produced certificates from their respective Heads of Departments stating their student status, can take part in the competition.)

3. **Prof. K. Anbazhakan Award** for Translation of Tolkappiyam in any international language, of Rs. 3,000/-. The book should have been published within a period of 3 years before  $1^{st}$  May 2016.

4. Award for the Best Monograph on Dravidian Tribes, of Rs. 3,000/-. It should have been published within a period of 3 years before  $1^{st}$  May 2016.

5. Shri. C. Achutha Menon Prize for the Best Article or Book published on `Computer and Language', of Rs. 2,000/-. It should have been published in an Indian journal and by an Indian, within a period of 3 years before  $I^{st}$  May 2016.

6. **Dr. George Jacob Award** for the Best Monograph on Dravidian Linguistics in any Indian language other than Dravidian, of Rs. 2,500/-. It should have been published within a period of 3 years before  $1^{st}$  May 2016.

7. **Prof. K.M. Venkataramaiah Award** for the Study of Linguistic Minorities, of Rs. 3,000/-. It should be an Indian publication, written in any international language other than Indian, and published within a period of 3 years before  $1^{st}$  May 2016.

8. Dr. Hermann Gundert Endowment Award for the Best Dictionary, Lexicon or Encyclopaedia on any major Dravidian Language or any Dravidian Tribal Language, of Rs. 3,000/-. It should have been published within a period of 3 years before  $1^{st}$  May 2016.

9. The Phonetic Society of India Endowment Award, of Rs. 3,000/- for a book on Phonetics in general or on Phonetics of any Indian language. It should have been published within a period of 3 years before  $I^{st}$  May 2016.

10. Dr. Panneerselvam & Smt. Thavamani Panneerselvam Award for the Translation of a Book from Tamil to Kannada or vice versa, Rs. 5,000/-. The book should have been published within a period of 3 years before  $1^{st}$  May 2016.

11. **Dr. K.N. Kuppuswamy Award** for a Lecture / Comparative Study of a Grammatical Text of Tamil, Sanskrit, Prakrit or Pali, of Rs. 1,500/-.

12. **Prof. Susheela Upadhyaya Award**, of Rs. 5,000/-, for a young researcher below 40 years who has produced a good monograph or Ph.D. research thesis or a good article on any branch of Modern Linguistics, within a period of 3 years before  $1^{st}$  May 2016.
