Elamite and Dravidian: A Reassessment (by Filippo Perdon, University of Naples, "L" Orientale", Italy), and 3. Dravidian Towns in the Mahavastu and Milindapanha - A Demographic Study (by Bryan G. Levman, University of Toronto, Canada). Nine awards were distributed in the 51st AICDL 2024 to the scholars in the field of Linguistics who were adjudged as winners. Dr George Jacob Award for the best monograph on Dravidian Linguistics in any Indian Language other than Dravidian was won by Dr.S.Thennarasu, Associate Professor.

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INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR ON ASPECTS OF BILINGUAL SPEECH AND BILINGUAL DEVELOPMENT



The Dept. of Linguistics, UCASS, Osmania University, organized International Webinar on Aspects of Bilingual Speech and Bilingual Development on 22 June 2024. Invited Speaker was Prof. Charles B. Chang, from Dept. of Linguistics, Boston University (BU), USA. He is also the Director of the Phonetics, Acquisition & Multilingualism Lab at BU. He spoke on the importance of bilingualism and emotional word development in children, who often exhibit different levels of competency in emotion words across their languages. Factors such as cultural norms, language proficiency, and context play significant roles in shaping how emotion words are used and understood by bilinguals. Dr. Chang also spoke on Bilingual Language in the context of alcohol intoxication and how the vowel space gets affected by it. Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Guest, Prof.K. Arjun Rao, Principal of UCASS, informed that India is a multilingual Country with many languages and cultures. Hence, Linguistic Diversity brings in Unity not only among people but also among communities. The Webinar was a grand success with more than 130 participants from all over India.
